



Vendor Application 32nd Annual Folk Festival July 9th & 10th, 2021

Folkfest is a celebration of life that takes place on the 2nd Saturday in July on South Cedar Street of Manistique, Michigan. Like most events throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, Folk Fest will most likely look different this year than years past, however, we're excited to be able offer this outdoor event for our community. We are working diligently to come up with unique ways to still provide the inviting, vibrant atmosphere that Folk Fest creates for our people and downtown area.

Eligibility:

Items crafted by the applying artist. Commercially produced items are welcome and will be accepted on a case-by-case basis. The Folk Fest Committee reserves the right to reject any items they may deem unacceptable up to the day of the show. Please contact Schoolcraft Tourism & Commerce at 906-341-5010 for more information.

Requirements:

- If applying as a Food Vendor, a food license must be obtained from the Schoolcraft County Health Department, and all state and local regulations must be met. A representative from the Health Department will do an onsite inspection. (License fees are the responsibility of the food vendor. If you have a commercial food license, you still need to submit the required paperwork to the Health Department.)
- Booth fee is required when submitting your application.

Entry Fees:

- Art & Craft Vendor: \$50.00
- Food Vendor: \$100.00
- Non-Profit Organization: \$30.00

Participation is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Return postmark will determine order of entries.

Applications Due by Friday, June 25, 2021

Entry fees will be returned if application is rejected. No refunds will be granted for cancellations.

Liability:

Completion and submission of the below application indicates your understanding and agreement that the Folk Fest Committee assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to any work, display, or personal property.

Sales:

All sales to be transacted by the artist. All proceeds go to the artist. Each artist is responsible for the collection of 6% Michigan sales tax. Payments made directly to the government authorities.
